At the discretion of the Committee, the running times for Junior and Senior/Master levels may be extended but not exceed 30 min. & 45 min. respectively. All levels will have a single course with a bird field. Either chucker and/or bobwhite quail will be used in all levels. Course and type of birds may be changed at the discretion of the Committee. Cancellation of event due to unsafe conditions or any other condition, refund of any entry fees, and substitution of judges is at the discretion of the Hunt Test Committee.

BITCHES IN SEASON

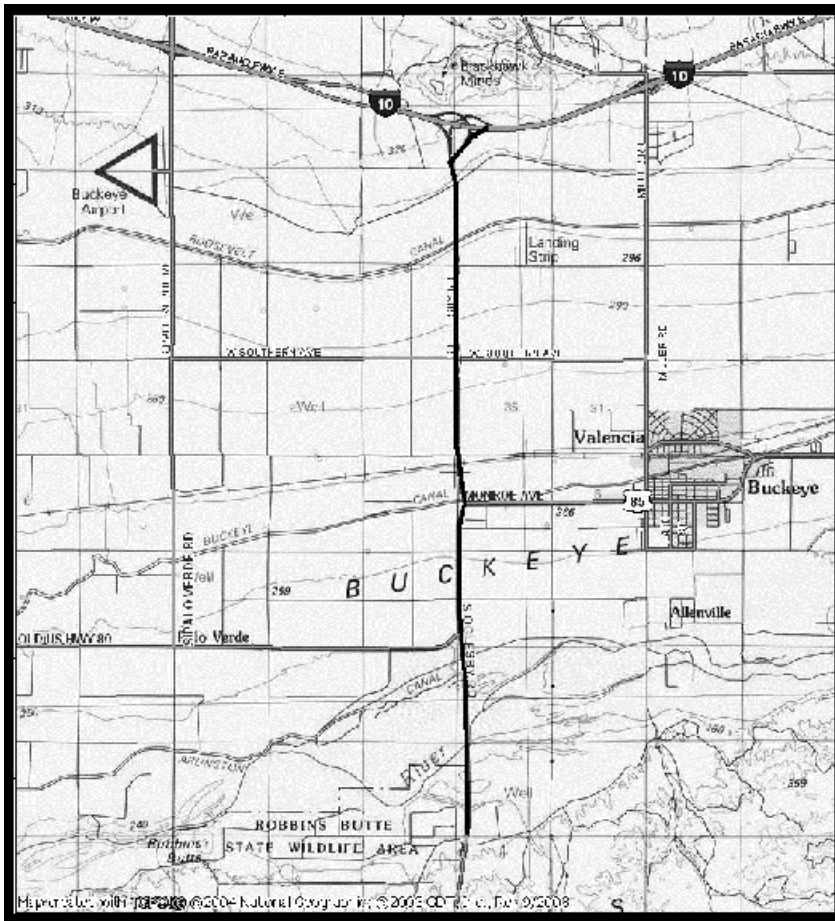
Per AKC Regulations, Ch. 1, Sec. 5, bitches in season are ineligible to enter and shall not be allowed on the grounds. Entry fees will be refunded for a bitch withdrawn for coming into season.

CONDUCT ON THE GROUNDS

During the running of a Hunting Test, there shall be no training on the grounds. During the running of a Hunting Test, there shall be no firing of live ammunition, except by the Official Gunners during the test. During the running of a Hunting Test, there shall be no firing of blank pistols, except by the handlers during their brace running time.

HUNT TEST DIRECTIONS

Take I-17 South to I-10 West
 Drive about 28 miles to Exit 112 – Hwy. 85 South to Yuma.
 Drive approximately 7.5 miles and turn right onto a dirt road
 at the Robbins Butte/Powers Butte Wildlife Area.
 Drive about 0.3 miles and bear **LEFT** at the “Y” with the
 sign “Powers Butte Wildlife Area (Robbins Butte)”
 Drive about 2.5 miles and look for the VSWC
 Hunt Test signs directing you to the training site and parking..

GUNS AND AMMUNITION

Handlers in all levels need a blank pistol, incapable of shooting live ammo. Handlers in the Master Level need to carry an empty shotgun. The Official Guns may carry only double barrel break apart shotguns of at least 20 gauge. Semi automatic and pump guns are prohibited.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Electronic devices, including beeper or locator collars, and dummy devices, as well as prong, pincher, or shock type collars, shall not be worn by a dog while it is running in a Hunting Test. Tracking collars will be permitted for use under AKC rules and regulations.

HUMANE TREATMENT OF GAME

AKC rules and regulations clearly prohibit any hobbling or shackling of game. **NO ONE** has the authority to order game crippled or maimed. Anyone guilty of violating AKC rules and regulations will be severely disciplined.
